

## **Early and Mid-Season Green & Blue/Green Cabbages**

TYPE	DAYS TO MATURITY	DESCRIPTION
Early Jersey Wakefield (OP) *HEIRLOOM	63 days	Tender-flavored conical heads about 7" across.
Golden Acre (OP) *HEIRLOOM	65 days	2 3/4 -4 lb. heads that are 5 1/2 -6" round.
Stonehead (Hybrid)	67 days	Mid-season, averages 4 lbs. & 6" round, very solid heads.
Savoy Blue (Hybrid)	80 days	Dark blue-green, round, flat, 3-6 lb. main season type.

## **Late Green Cabbages**

TYPE	DAYS TO MATURITY	DESCRIPTION
Premium Late Flat Dutch (OP) *HEIRLOOM	100 days	Huge heads (more than 12" across) & 10-12 lbs. or more. Best variety for sauerkraut.
Princeton (Hybrid)	110 days	Long-term storage type with 5-8 lb., round heads.

## **Red Cabbages**

TYPE	DAYS TO MATURITY	DESCRIPTION
Ruby (Red) Dynasty (Hybrid)	75 days	Later season, oval/round 6-6 1/4", 3 1/4-5 lb. heads.
Rona Red (Hybrid)	98 days	Late season, nice round heads with thick wrapped leaves. Great storage type.

## **Green Lettuces**

TYPE	DAYS TO MATURITY	DESCRIPTION
Sulu	28 days	Early lime green, large oak leaf variety.
Green Salad Bowl	44 days	Early variety that produces flavorful green leaf lettuce. As outer leaves are picked, inner leaves keep producing. Ideal for hot weather as it is slow to bolt.

Grand Rapids M.I.	45 days	Early variety that produces green loose leaf lettuce. As outer leaves are picked, inner leaves keep producing.
Buttercrunch (Hybrid)	60 days	Medium green, longstanding, sweet & tender Bibb type.
Green Towers (Hybrid)	74 days	Most popular Romaine for our area. Dark green, extra large upright type.
Mighty Joe (Hybrid)	80 days	(Iceberg) Head lettuce. Very uniform, round heads.

Simply Salad Global Gourmet Mix (Available in color bowls & small pots)	14-21 days	Mix of red & green leaf lettuces with spicy Asian greens. Great in salads or stir fries.

### **Red Lettuces**

<b>TYPE</b>	<b>DAYS TO MATURITY</b>	<b>DESCRIPTION</b>
Red Sails	40 days	Slowest bolting red loose leaf lettuce. Tastes mild for a long time without bitterness.
Red Salad Bowl MI	51 days	Wine red oak leaf.
New Red Fire	55 days	Produces heavy heads of "frilly" leaves.

## **Cucumbers**

<b>TYPE</b>	<b>DAYS TO MATURITY</b>	<b>DESCRIPTION</b>
Bush Pickle (Hybrid) *PICKLE TYPE	45 days	4-5" long pickle type for containers, small areas or miniature gardens.
English Telegraph (OP) *HEIRLOOM	45 days	Extra long, slim, straight & symmetrical European type.
Northern Pickling (OP) *PICKLE TYPE	48 days	High-yielding pickle type.
Cross Country (Hybrid) *PICKLE TYPE	51 days	High-yielding semi-bush pickle type.
Diva (Hybrid) *AAS Winner *BURPLESS TYPE	58 days	"Like a regular cucumber but with smoother, thin, no-peel skin." Tender, crisp, non-bitter & seedless. Best flavor when size of a pickle.
Sweet Slice (Hybrid) *BURPLESS TYPE	62 days	Sweet, burpless, 10-12" long, slicing type.

## **Eggplant**

<b>TYPE</b>	<b>DAYS TO MATURITY</b>	<b>DESCRIPTION</b>
Hansel Hybrid	55 days	High yields of 2-10" long dark purple fruit, no bitterness & few seeds.
Orient Express Hybrid	58 days	Slender, 8-10" long x 1 1/2-2 1/2" diameter. Able to set fruit in cool weather as well as under heat stress. Tender, delicately flavored, and quick cooking.
Classic F1 Hybrid	78 days	Produces good yields of 8" x 9" purple-black teardrop shaped eggplants. Great for slicing, stuffing, and baking.
Orient Charm Hybrid	65 days	Pink-white Orient Express type with 8-10" x 1 3/8" fruits. Strong plant with high yields.

## Green/Red/Yellow/Orange Sweet Peppers

TYPE	DAYS TO MATURITY	DESCRIPTION
Gypsy (Hybrid)	60 days	AAS Winner. Early, heavy producer of wedge-shaped sweet, crunchy peppers with Good yielder, all season long. TMV resistant.
King of the North (OP) *HEIRLOOM *STUFFING TYPE	60-65 days	6" long & 4" across. Thick walled, sweet, mild tasting bell type. Grows good in this area. Great for stuffing!
New Ace (Hybrid) *STUFFING TYPE	65 days	Extra-early, prolific deep green, large sweet type. Stuffing type.
Red Knight X3R (Hybrid)	65-70 days	Early pepper with main-season size. Excellent fruit quality at red stage.
Cubanelle (OP) *HEIRLOOM *ITALIAN GOURMET FRYING	68 days	Large 6" x 2", smooth, lime green, tapered sweet frying type.
Big Bertha (Hybrid) *STUFFING TYPE	70 days	Giant 7" x 4", sweet bell type. Great for stuffing!
Giant Aconcagua (OP)	70 days	Heavy producer of 12" oblong "as sweet as apples" fruits. Can use when light green but sweetest when red.
Lady Bell (Hybrid)	71 days	Consistent performer in the Northeast. Prolific even in cooler weather. Medium-thick-walled, green 3 to 4 lobed fruits ripen to red.
Bell Boy (Hybrid) *STUFFING TYPE	72 days	4 ½", 4-lobed with thick walls. Stuffing type.
Giant Marconi (Hybrid) *ITALIAN GOURMET FRYING	72 days	Grilling pepper. About 6 to 8 inches long. Green to red when mature. Tastes excellent raw but best when grilled. It has a memorable sweet, smoky flavor. Judged best in its class for earliness, yield, pepper size and flavor.

Corno Di Toro (OP) *HEIRLOOM *ITALIAN GOURMET FRYING	72 days	'Horn of the Bull' pepper imported from Italy with fruits 8 to 10 inches long. Ripens to red. Good in salads, grilled or sauteed.
Carmen (Hybrid) *ITALIAN GOURMET FRYING	60 days to green 80 days to red	Similar to Corno Di Toro. Good for salads & roasting, especially when fully ripe.
Delirio Orange (Hybrid)	Mid-Early Season	New hybrid sweet bell pepper matures from green to a shiny orange. Block shaped, thick walled, large, 4-lobed fruit. TSWV resistant.
Sirius Yellow (Hybrid)	Mid-Season	Large green to yellow bell pepper which is extremely productive. TMV resistant. Grows where disease may be a problem.
Pimento Elite F1 (Hybrid)	72-75 days	Dark green to red. Heart shaped, 3" x 3 1/2" fruits with sweet flesh & thick walls.
Golden Marconi (OP) *HEIRLOOM	80 days	A late, big, yellow, 7", very sweet, Italian frying-type pepper.

### **Mildly Hot & Hot Peppers**

<b>TYPE</b>	<b>DAYS TO MATURITY</b>	<b>DESCRIPTION</b>
Hot Hungarian Wax (OP)	60 days	Medium hot 6-6 1/2" long (banana type). Ripen green/yellow/red.
Ring of Fire (OP)	60 days	Early, short (4" long) smooth cayenne type. Very hot!
Serrano Del Sol (Hybrid)	62 days	Chili type that is hot but not too hot with a unique flavor. Good for sauces & salsa. Dark green matures red.
Inferno (Hybrid)	65 days	Productive hot banana type that ripens yellow/red.

Czech Black (OP)	65 days	Produces 2-1/2" cone-shaped peppers that mature from black to garnet. A little less heat than Jalapeno.
Jalapeno (OP)	70 days	Dark green, 3 1/2" long, 1 1/2" hot fruit that matures red.
Garden Salsa (Hybrid)	73 days	Great chili pepper for Mexican sauces and fresh salsa. Grows 8 to 9 inches. Will turn red if left on the plant (but is best picked green for salsa). TMV resistant.
Ancho (Hybrid)	75 days	Mild poblano chile rellano type. Called "Ancho" when dried. Dark green, 5 1/2" fruits are a favorite for roasting. One of the mildest chiles. A better yielder than most others of its type.
Super Chili (Hybrid)	75 days	Chili pepper that turns green to orange to red.
Pasilla Bajio (Hybrid)	78 days	Heavy producer of berry, almost herbal, flavored 8 to 10" thin-walled, slender, dark blackish-green peppers which mature dark brown. Popular "chile negro" pepper. Classified as a hot pepper but Pasilla ("little raisin") has almost no heat.
Poblano L (Hybrid)	75-80 days	Mildly hot, very dark green fruits mature to almost brown and are 5 x 2-1/2". Called Poblano when fresh & Ancho when dried.
Large Red Hot Cherry (Hybrid)	80 days	Large producer of very hot, dark green to cherry red fruits that are 2-1/2" to 3" across.

Orange Habanero (OP)	85 days	Very hot, small silver dollar sized type that turn green/gold/pale orange/red.
Holy Mole (Hybrid)	85 days	2007 AAS Winner. Gourmet quality. High-yielding, crunchy 7-9" x 1-1/2" fruits that start out bright green & then warm/chocolate brown over the next 2 weeks. A distinctive but not overly spicy pepper, used in Mexico's famous Mole sauce. Early fruits sliced for toppings & baking, while fully mature fruits can be dried and ground.
Joe's Long Cayenne (OP)	60 days to green 85 days to red ripe	Produces 8-10" long, thin-fleshed fruits that taper to a skinny point. Original seeds came from Calabria, Italy. Turns bright red for homemade hot sauce and dries well for hot pepper flakes.
Chiltepin (OP)	90 days	Ranked among the top 3 hottest peppers on the market. Prolific, pea-like, 1/2" sized, extremely hot fruits.
Chocolate Habanero (OP)	95 days	Produce large yields of 2 x 1.5", thin-walled green fruits that mature to chocolate color with a unique rich flavor. They can be dried and smoked like Chipotle peppers.
Ghost Pepper (Hybrid)	100-120 days	"One of the world's hottest, if not the hottest." Thin-walled, 2-3 inch, wrinkled, pointy fruits. Ripen mostly to red.

## **Cauliflower**

<b>TYPE</b>	<b>DAYS TO MATURITY</b>	<b>DESCRIPTION</b>
Snow Crown (Hybrid)	50 days	Produces firm 7 to 8 in. rounded heads. Must be tied for best quality.
Minuteman (Hybrid)	51 days	Early type. Up to 2 ¼ lbs.
White Sails (Hybrid)	68 days	Late main season type. Self-wrapping with 7 ½" heads.
Artica (Hybrid)	80 days	Late season type. Heavy, dense, high dome self wrap heads.

Veronica (Romanesco) (Hybrid)	77 days	Delicious, sweet, nutty flavor milder than cauliflower. Holds color when cooked. Best when heads are small.
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## **Broccoli**

<b>TYPE</b>	<b>DAYS TO MATURITY</b>	<b>DESCRIPTION</b>
Green Goliath (Hybrid)	76 days	Huge 10-12" medium green heads. Short bushy plants.

Sorrento Raab	55 days	Early spring raab with dime-sized buds.
Zamboni (Spring Raab)	70 days	Produces larger-sized buds than Sorrento Raab.

Giant Prague (Celeriac)	110 days	Elite European strain of what is known as "turnip rooted celery."
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## **White & Purple Kohlrabi**

<b>TYPE</b>	<b>DAYS TO MATURITY</b>	<b>DESCRIPTION</b>
Early Purple Vienna (Hybrid)	55 days	Red-purple, flat-globed kohlrabi.
Winner Hybrid	57 days	Heavy-yielding, semi-globed white kohlrabi.



## Celery

<b>TYPE</b>	<b>DAYS TO MATURITY</b>	<b>DESCRIPTION</b>
Giant Summer Pascal *HEIRLOOM	125 days	Produces jumbo size celery. Easy to blanch. A dozen stalks weigh around 10 to 15 lbs.

<b>TYPE</b>	<b>DAYS TO MATURITY</b>	<b>DESCRIPTION</b>
Jade Cross E Hybrid	80 days	Heavy yields of solid, tight formed, 1 ½" blue-green sprouts.
Hilds Ideal	120 days	Known for sweetness & cold hardiness.

## Kale

Vates Blue Curled	56 days	Standard blue/green curled variety.
Siberian	60 days	One of the best varieties for salads. "Light frost improves flavor."

## Squashes

<b>TYPE</b>	<b>DAYS TO MATURITY</b>	<b>DESCRIPTION</b>
Raven F1 (Hybrid)	48 days	High-yielding, dark green, glossy, smooth fruits---zucchini type.
Early Golden Crookneck	48 days	High-yielding, yellow crookneck squash.
Dark Green Zucchini (Hybrid)	50 days	10-12" straight green zucchini. Very prolific.
Clarita (Hybrid)	51 days	Middle Eastern lighter green, 6 in. couasa type squash.
Gold Rush Summer Squash (Hybrid) *AAS Winner	55 days	Bright golden-yellow 8" zucchini with high yields on compact plants. Attractive color and gourmet quality. Best when picked at the 8-10 inch stage. Sweet white flesh is a tasty addition to raw & cooked dishes.
Vegetable Spaghetti Squash	70 days	Harvest when 8 to 10" long. "Spaghetti-like pulp."

Cream of the Crop (Hybrid)	75 days	White 7.5 x 6 in. acorn squash.
Butternut Supreme (Hybrid)	87 days	12"tan fruit.
Buttercup (Hybrid)	90 days	Finest buttercup. 3-4 lb., dark green with deep orange flesh. Sweet.
Delicata/Sweet Potato Squash	100 days	Long-keeping winter variety with 6 to 8" fruits with cream/green striped skin with sweet taste similar to sweet potatoes.
Metro PMR F1 (Hybrid)	105 days	Smaller, sweeter Butternut type, avg. 2 1/2-3 1/2 lb. Powdery mildew resistant.
Blue Hubbard Squash (Heirloom)	110 days	Produces 15-40 lb. fruits that are great for baking, pies & soup. Long storage type.

## **Watermelon & Pumpkins**

<b>TYPE</b>	<b>DAYS TO MATURITY</b>	<b>DESCRIPTION</b>
Sugar Baby Watermelon (OP)	75 days	Early & productive, small round 7-8" fruits with red, sweet & flavorful flesh.
Crimson Sweet Watermelon (OP)	96 days	Oval, light green fruit with dark stripes. 15-25 lbs. with dark red flesh.
Oktoberfest (Hybrid)	95 days	Round pumpkin with thick, black handles measuring 2.5-3" diameter. Good orange color. Standard large "Jack-O-Lantern" type.
Sweet Sugar Pie (Hybrid)	88-100 days	Produce 6-7" pie pumpkins which make rich pumpkin pies.
Dill's Atlantic Giant Pumpkin (Hybrid)	120 days	Giant pumpkins "For world record pumpkin contests."

## **Muskmelon**

<b>TYPE</b>	<b>DAYS TO MATURITY</b>	<b>DESCRIPTION</b>
Athena Hybrid	75 days	5-6 lbs with small seed cavity. Firm with excellent flavor. Produces heavy yields.

## **Tomatoes**

<b>TYPE</b>	<b>DAYS TO MATURITY</b>	<b>DESCRIPTION</b>
Fourth of July (Hybrid) Indeterminate	49 days	Earliest, 4 oz. red tomatoes by the 4th of July.
Early Girl (Hybrid) Indeterminate	57 days	"One of the earliest slicing types." Produces heavy yields of firm, blemish-resistant, meaty 4-6 oz. red fruits.
Beefmaster (Hybrid) Indeterminate	60 days	Large, 20 oz. red beefsteak type.
Goliath (Hybrid) Indeterminate	65 days	10-15 oz. bright red, sweet flavored fruits with high yields. Good for sandwiches.
Fantastic (Hybrid) Semi-Determinate	65 days	Scarlet red, medium-sized fruits that are almost crack-free. Heavy yields. Great for canning/making juice!
Jet Star (Hybrid) Indeterminate	70 days	Prolific big red fruits that ripen all the way through. "Free of cracks & scars." Terrific flavor with low acidity. Good eating tomato!
Celebrity (Hybrid) Semi-Determinate	70 days	Do best when staked. Bright red 8 oz. fruits. Good for canning.
Better Boy (Hybrid) Indeterminate	72 days	Average 16 oz. red fruits.
Marglobe Select (OP) Indeterminate <b>*HEIRLOOM</b>	72 days	High yielding, large red, sweet, thick walled fruits.
Big Beef VFNT (Hybrid) Indeterminate	73 days	10-12" beefsteak type tomato. Good disease tolerance. All American Winner.

Orange Wellington (Hybrid) Indeterminate	75 days	Produces fruits with large, firm, dense, meaty flesh that are nearly seedless.
Glamour (OP) Indeterminate <b>*HEIRLOOM</b>	75 days	Main season variety, red fruits, good for canning.
Sunray (OP) Indeterminate <b>*HEIRLOOM</b>	75 days	Produces moderate to heavy yields of 8-10 oz., smooth, round, sweet, golden-yellow fruits. Low acidity.
Iron Lady (Hybrid) Determinante	75 days	"Triple disease resistant mid-size red slicer" with 5 oz., 3-4 in. size fruits.
SteakHouse Hybrid Indeterminate	75-80 days	"The world's largest beefsteak." Fruits weigh up to 3 lbs.
La Roma III (Hybrid) Determinante	76 days	Large, red 5-8 oz. paste type.
Burpee's Big Boy (Hybrid) Indeterminate	78 days	Red, 1 lb. or more, crack-free beefsteak type with thick meaty flesh. Great for slicing!
San Marzano (OP) Determinante <b>*HEIRLOOM</b>	80 days	Elongated 3" long x 1 ½" thick plum/paste type. Great for canning!
Big Mama (Hybrid) Indeterminate	80 days	Large 5 x 3" plum tomatoes with easy to peel skins. Great for canning.

### **Cherry, Grape and Pear Tomatoes**

<b>TYPE</b>	<b>DAYS TO MATURITY</b>	<b>DESCRIPTION</b>
Sungold (Hybrid) Indeterminate	57 days	Very sweet, golden cherry type.
Sweet 100 (Hybrid) Indeterminate	65 days	Produces large clusters of ½" very sweet red cherry fruits.
Artisan Pink Tiger (Hybrid)	70 days	Produces high yields of unique julienne cherry tomatoes that are very sweet, juicy & tropical flavored. Fruits can be picked premature & ripen off the vine. Crack resistant.

Yellow Pear (OP) Indeterminate <b>*HEIRLOOM</b>	75-78 days	¾-1 oz. lemon yellow pear-shaped salad type with mild flavor.
Red Grape (Hybrid) Indeterminate	75 days	Red grape type. Tolerant to late blight & leaf spot virus. Crack resistant.

### **\*Pink Heirloom Tomatoes**

<b>TYPE</b>	<b>DAYS TO MATURITY</b>	<b>DESCRIPTION</b>
Brandywine Semi-determinate	80 days	"The most popular heirloom vegetable!" Large fruits with great flavor. Potato leaf variety from 1885. Pinkish-red up to 1 ½ lbs. each.
Mortgage Lifter Indeterminate	85 days	Large, smooth, 1-lb. pink type with a delicious, rich, sweet taste. Developed by M.C. Byles of Logan, West Virginia. He sold plants for \$1 in the 1940s & paid off his \$6000 mortgage on his house.

### **\*Green Heirloom Tomatoes**

<b>TYPE</b>	<b>DAYS TO MATURITY</b>	<b>DESCRIPTION</b>
Green Zebra Indeterminate	75 days	Chartreuse with deep lime-green stripes. Rich tasting, sweet with a sharp bite. A favorite of many high class chefs. Excellent yields. "This is the tomato colored for the Green Bay Packers."
Aunt Ruby's German Green Indeterminate	85 days	One of the largest green beefsteak types. Can grow over 1 lb. Neon-green flesh with a strong, sweet & fruity flavor.

## \*Striped/Bicolor/Heirloom Tomatoes

TYPE	DAYS TO MATURITY	DESCRIPTION
Speckled Roman Indeterminate	75 days	High yields of meaty, 4-6" long orange-red paste type with wavy yellow stripes. Good flavor.
Pineapple Indeterminate	75-95 days	Large up to 2 lb. yellow fruits with red marbling. Very sweet & fruity with good yields.
Ananas Noire or Black Pineapple <b>*NEW!</b>	75-95 days	Multi-colored, heavy producer of 1-1/2 lb., smooth, superb flavored, sweet & smoky with a hint of citrus fruits (green, yellow and purple mix) Bright green with deep red-streaked flesh. An unusual variety developed by Pascal Moreau, a horticulturist from Belgium.
Striped German Indeterminate	78 days	Flat, medium to large, bicolored red/yellow fruits. Beautiful slices. Complex, fruity flavor and smooth texture.
Copia Indeterminate	80-90 days	Large, beautiful, unique, glowing gold & neon red, striped flavorful fruits. Insides are red & yellow swirled.

## **\*Red & Orange Heirloom Tomatoes**

TYPE	DAYS TO MATURITY	DESCRIPTION
Stupice Indeterminate	55-60 days	Czechoslovakian red, small snacking type fruits on potato leaf plants.
Bloody Butcher Indeterminate	60 days	Small, deep red, 3-4 oz. 'cluster' type with nice flavor. Good production. Ripens around the same time as Early Girl & is much tastier.
Heinz 2653 Determinante	68 days	Early producer of 2-1/2 to 3 oz. fruits great for canning.
Sioux Indeterminate	70 days	Produces large harvests of round, incredibly sweet & tangy, complex-flavored 6 oz. fruits even in hot weather.
Polish Linguisa Indeterminate	73 days	High yields of 10 oz. red paste type fruits. Very sweet and very productive. From New York dating back to the 1800s.
Bellstar Paste Indeterminate	74 days	Produces 4 oz. round paste fruits. Good in salads & for canning. Long season ripening.
Orange Strawberry <b>*NEW!</b>	75 days	Brilliant orange, oxheart fruits. Sometimes reach 1-lb. with meaty, robust, complex & surprisingly tart flavor. Good for canning or sauce.
Dr. Walter	75 days	6-8 oz. red globe-shaped, smooth fruit with good flavor. Great producer. Popular in New Zealand. Some disease resistance.

Goldie Indeterminate	75 days	Rich flavored, deep orange beefsteak type averaging 16 to 20 oz. "Don't harvest until it has a distinct rosy blush."
Valencia Indeterminate	76 days	Round, smooth 8-10 oz., meaty fruits with few seeds. A Maine family heirloom with a Spanish accent.
Burpee Delicious Indeterminate	77 days	1 lb. or larger, smooth, red, meaty with few seeds, somewhat crack resistant.
Amish Paste Indeterminate	80 days	High yields of 8 to 12 oz. red paste type fruits. Mildly sweet.
Dr. Wyche's Yellow	80 days	Solid, smooth tangerine-orange fruit with tropical, sweet taste. Heavy yields. Introduced to Seed Saver's Exchange by the late Dr. John Wyche, who at one time owned the Cole Brothers & used elephant manure to fertilize his gardens.
Opalka Indeterminate	85 days	High yields of 6" long x 3" wide red paste type fruits. Excellent sweet flavor. Very few seeds. From Poland.
Orange Banana Paste Indeterminate	85 days	Produces 3-4" long, 4 to 5 oz. fruits. Very good flavor & sweetness. Great for canning & drying.
Hog Heart Paste Indeterminate	86 days	Produces 6-8 oz. banana pepper shaped fruits. Sometimes produces heart-shaped double fruits. Meaty, noted for sparse seed cavity. Great for canning.



Abraham Lincoln Indeterminate	87 days	Produces good yields of extra large 1 lb. meaty fruits. Crack resistant. Good for making ketchup, tomato juice & slicing.
Jersey Devil *NEW!	90 days	Pointed, pepper-like 5-6", ruby-red, paste-type fruits, very meaty & few seeds. Great flavor. Ancestor to "Jersey Giant."

### **\*Purple/Black/Chocolate Heirloom Tomatoes**

<b>TYPE</b>	<b>DAYS TO MATURITY</b>	<b>DESCRIPTION</b>
